

Taipei Culture Camp

The Deer Valley Unified School District (DVUSD) hosted the award-winning Taipei Chinese Culture Camp this summer for one week at Stetson Hills School and Sandra Day O'Connor High School. This was the camp's 27th anniversary and the first of its kind in DVSUD. Taipei, Taiwan has had a long sister-city relationship with Phoenix which started back in 1979. The camp has been recognized for its unique cultural service, quality, and breadth by the U.S. Department of Education, Arizona Department of Education, City of Phoenix, State of Arizona, and numerous national, state, and local officials.



Although DVUSD has the longest running Mandarin immersion schools and programs in the state, we had never hosted a camp for first through ninth grade students on the Chinese culture found in Taiwan. The summer camp experience was filled to capacity right away and hosted specialized teachers from Taiwan who worked in concert with DVUSD teachers and staff to bring over 300 students a unique and special experience.

During the camp, students focused on the Taiwanese culture, folk art, country sports, yo-yo competitions, Kung Fu, painting, and crafts. Students enjoyed learning about how to perform the Dragon and Lion Dances in full costumes, paper cutting and folding art, and the movement of folk dances in time with a professional dance drummer. All of the students experienced Mandarin calligraphy, music, songs, language, and history as they learned the path of Taiwan and its relationship to Phoenix.

Over 300 Taiwanese students arrived to DVUSD this past school year from the build-up of the Taiwan Semiconductor Manufacturing Company (TSMC) beginning their two factories in the geographical center of DVUSD. The integration of these students into our system took a year-long effort of coordination and teamwork to ensure students could have a successful school year. TSMC is expected to bring workers from all over the world which will have a profound impact on DVUSD's future. These TSMC factories are going to be the most efficient and high-tech computer chip-manufacturing facilities in the world and will attract up to 40 different feeder companies, much like Intel in Chandler. Intel currently has 10,000 employees at their two Arizona campuses.

DVUSD is looking forward to coordinating more events that celebrate the culture of Taiwan. We anticipate the sister-city relationship between Phoenix and Taipei to strengthen over time with the addition of TSMC to our city. DVUSD will continue to offer Mandarin immersion and language programs in several of our schools, all with the objective of giving our students a competitive advantage in the world. 




